2 (Whereupon Judge Block takes the bench.)

3 MS. POKORNY: Hello.

4 COURT REPORTER: Good afternoon, Your Honor.

5 MR. RABKIN: How are you?

6 How are you, Judge?

7 THE COURT: Fine, and you?

8 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: You saw Carolyn's most
9 recent submission, right? The revised --

10 THE COURT: I got it.

11 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: Okay.

12 That was something new.

13 THE COURT: Is Mr. Batchelder here?

14 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: Yes. He is in with
15 Mr. Wright.

16 THE COURT: All right.

17 (Whereupon Mr. Batchelder, the defendant, and Deputy
18 U.S. Marshal Alvarez and Deputy U.S. Marshal Vavasis enter the
19 courtroom.)

20 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: Well, Mr. Wright looks
21 better today. He looked like he was depressed and a broken
22 man the last time.

23 (Whereupon the defendant turns towards Ms. Pokorny
24 and attacks her.)

25 (Whereupon there is screaming.)

1 COURT REPORTER: You cock sucker get off of her. Get
2 off of her. Get off of her. You cock sucker get off of her.

3 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Get off of her.

4 COURT REPORTER: I will beat the shit out of you,
5 you motherfucker. You cock sucker. Who the fuck do you think
6 you are?

7 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Get off.

8 COURT REPORTER: Try it on me, man. I'll kick you in
9 the fuckin balls.

10 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Get off her.

11 THE DEFENDANT: I apologize.

12 COURT REPORTER: You apologize, you piece of shit.

13 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Get off of her.

14 THE DEFENDANT: They are choking me.

15 COURT REPORTER: You fuckin put your hands behind
16 your back, you cock sucker.

17 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Put your hands behind your
18 back.

19 COURT REPORTER: Behind your back. Put them back
20 there a minute.

21 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Just hook him up right there.

22 U. S. MARSHAL VAVASIS: Turn him around, Turn him
23 around. Hook him up. Hook him up.

24 Push it in.

25 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Turn him around.

1 Turn around, sir. Turn around.

2 U. S. MARSHAL VAVASIS: Turn around, you asshole.

3 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Turn around.

4 U. S. MARSHAL VAVASIS: Put your hands behind your
5 back.

6 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Put your hands behind your
7 back.

8 THE DEFENDANT: Okay, move them --

9 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Move your hands behind your
10 back.

11 Move them now.

12 COURT REPORTER: I got one. I got one hand. I got
13 one. I got one.

14 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Put your hands behind your
15 back.

16 COURT REPORTER: Get the other one. Cuff from the
17 other.

18 U. S. MARSHAL VAVASIS: You fuckin asshole. You
19 motherfucker.

20 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Leave him there now.

21 COURT REPORTER: You cocksucker.

22 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Leave him there.

23 COURT REPORTER: Fuckin shit. Son of a bitch.

24 I'm all right. Where is Carolyn.

25 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: I told her to leave.

1 COURT REPORTER: Is she all right?

2 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: I told her to leave.

3 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: (Talking in background.) If
4 he had handcuffs and there might be --

5 UNKNOWN VOICE: Thirty.

6 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Is she all right?

7 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: I told her to leave.

8 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Where is she?

9 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: I told her to leave. She
10 is outside.

11 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Did you press this in?

12 COURT REPORTER: Press it in.

13 U. S. MARSHAL VAVASIS: Don't move at all. Why did
14 you do that for?

15 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: That is what I am saying.
16 It wasn't doing nothing.

17 COURT REPORTER: It is supposed to do something. It
18 is not doing anything.

19 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: Right?

20 COURT REPORTER: Right.

21 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: I am pressing it in and it
22 is not going in.

23 COURT REPORTER: Try his.

24 COURT SECURITY OFFICER: It is.

25 COURT REPORTER: It works?

1 COURT SECURITY OFFICER: You have to pull it.

2 COURT REPORTER: Pull it?

3 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: I was pressing it in, you
4 know.

5 In the old building you used to press it in.

6 COURT REPORTER: I don't understand why these guys
7 cannot be brought out in handcuffs. It makes no sense at all.
8 No sense at all. None at all. It is insane.

9 COURT SECURITY OFFICER: Yeah, the 10th floor.

10 COURT REPORTER: Fuck. He has keys hanging from him
11 right over there.

12 (Whereupon U.S. Marshal Vavasis removes a set of
13 keys hanging from the defendant's clothes.)

14 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: Wow.

15 I saw that --

16 COURT REPORTER: It got to be reset by them with a
17 key.

18 COURT SECURITY OFFICER: No, we have to reset it
19 with a key.

20 COURT REPORTER: Did it work?

21 COURT SECURITY OFFICER: Yes, it did work.

22 FEMALE COURT SECURITY OFFICER: 10-4 control, we
23 need an ambulance. 10-4. In 10-C we need an ambulance to be
24 called, please.

25 CONTROL: 10-4.

1 COURT REPORTER: Is she all right, Carolyn?

2 FEMALE COURT SECURITY OFFICER: She wants an
3 ambul ance.

4 COURT REPORTER: Good. All right.

5 You will have to put this over.

6 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: No shit, Sherlock.

7 COURT REPORTER: Yeah.

8 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: She is feeling okay but she
9 got like some bruises.

10 COURT REPORTER: You better get an ambulance.

11 U. S. MARSHAL VAVASIS: We are just going to take
12 this guy in the back --

13 CONTROL: 10-4.

14 COURT REPORTER: This is going to be put over
15 anyway.

16 U. S. MARSHAL ALVAREZ: Yeah, I know.

17 COURT REPORTER: It can be put over because we are
18 not doing nothing today.

19 I have it on audio. I have it all on audio.

20 That fuckin --

21 (Telephone ringing.)

22 THE COURT: The marshals are here?

23 COURT REPORTER: Two Marshals are here. They took
24 him down. They took him down, Judge.

25 Carolyn is going to have an ambulance to go to the

1 hospital.

2 THE COURT: What happened to her?

3 COURT REPORTER: She got all bruised, Your Honor.

4 She wants to go to the hospital. I guess we are going to put
5 this over?

6 THE COURT: Yes, it is going to be put over.

7 COURT REPORTER: Yes.

8 THE COURT: But why didn't the Marshals respond?
9 This thing did not work, Mike? I am terribly concerned about
10 this.

11 COURTROOM DEPUTY CLERK: All right. In the old
